



# REMINDER

## 340B Drug Identification on Medical claims

**Summary:** Originally effective July 1, 2015, this is a reminder that providers who bill for drugs on a medical claim must use a UD modifier when billing for drugs obtained through the 340B drug discount program.

**What this means to you:**

**Providers participating in the 340B drug discount program must submit each drug line with modifier UD** on the revenue line with the HCPCS/CPT procedure code and NDC for revenue codes 0250 through 0259 and 0636 through 0639. All providers, including those not participating in the 340B discount program, must continue to submit NDC codes for revenue codes 250 through 259 and 636 through 639 and applicable HCPCS/CPT codes for each drug submitted.

**Note: Each drug line must be submitted with modifier UD on the revenue line with the procedure code and NDC code.**

**When does this change become effective?**

◆ This became effective July 1, 2015; this serves as a reminder to bill for drugs on a medical claim using a UD modifier when billing for drugs obtained through the 340B drug discount program.
