



## HEDIS QUICK REFERENCE BILLING CODES

### Immediate Benefits:

- **Elimination or decrease** in onsite HEDIS medical record reviews

### **ALERT!**

- Sports physicals may be billed as well visits if all three components are clearly documented and dated on the same day in the medical record: (1) Physical exam, (2) developmental level and (3) anticipatory guidance. Please add the BMI Percentile to the record.
- Occasionally, two codes may be necessary (e.g., 99052 or 99050) to indicate after hours services.

**NOTE:** You must also use 99382 or 99201 to indicate an office visit.

**Requirement:** At least one capillary or venous blood test on or before the child's second birthday

\*\*The two-dose Hepatitis B antigen Recombivax, is recommended for children between 11 and 14 years of age only, and is not included in this table.
